DRAFTSMANSHIP

Rules:

1. The topic will be given on the spot and use of internet is disallowed unless for the reference of bare acts.
2. Time Limit: 45 minutes inclusive of everything.
3. **FORMAT OF THE DOCUMENT:** The draft should be in Times New Roman in 12 font size. A line spacing of 1.5 for the document is to be adhered.
4. One should make sure that none of the facts are omitted or admitted at random. Negative statements should be avoided.
5. Technical language should be followed.
6. The legal language employed should be precise and accurate.
7. Draft should be readily intelligible.
8. Due care and attention should be placed on the rules of legal interpretation.
9. The drafted document should be clearly understood by a person who has competent knowledge of the subject matter.
10. The draft should be self-explanatory as far as possible.
11. The draft should be divided into paragraphs and each paragraph should contain a distinct subject matter.
12. Arrangement of facts should be done logically.
13. Use numbers and letters for sub-clauses and paragraphs.
14. Choice of words should be such that they easily convey the meaning of the writer.
15. The participants are strictly advised not to disclose the name of their College/Institution to the Jury members/audience.
16. The organizing committee reserves all rights to change or modify the event, rules, venue, and time as it deems fit.
17. The decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final and binding.
18. Any argument, disobedience, use of expletives or aggressive behavior shall result in immediate disqualification.
